## From Miracle Corners of the World To Tanzania with Love

A container going from New York to Tanzania was packed to its fullest capacity. Almost every square inch was filled with boxes of computers, books, school supplies, medical equipment and other donations which will all go to Tanzania. It was a very tiring day for all those who helped, but well worth it. Just about every single item that has been donated over the past few months was packed into boxes and placed into the container. Below is just a quick approximation of what was sent on the container:

- Several hundred of boxes of books (almost 20,000 pounds) donated by McGraw Hill which will be donated to the university in Iringa's library
- Approximately 14 more boxes of miscellaneous books including medical text books which will also go to Iringa.
- 8 boxes of Religious Education books which will be on the Religious Education shelf in the university in Iringa.
- 44 Boxes of Dental equipment/supplies which be used in Songea for future health care outreaches.
- Over 22 Boxes of Computers, monitors, keyboards, etc. will be sent to Arusha for use in the Herman Wrice Community Center. (each box is stuffed with clothing to be donated)
- 8 Boxes of dental supplies which will be donated to the Dar es Salaam Dental school.
- 8 boxes of sports equipment, school supplies and equipment and other children's objects as well as a few computers will be sent to Songea

Without the dedication, commitment and hard work of all the supporters and those who donated, all of this would have been near impossible and extremely difficult to have been achieved.
