EVENT 1: Rwanda Genocide Remembered: Commemoration in Film and Dialogue

Where: The Museum of Jewish Heritage: A Living Memorial to the Holocaust, NYC

On the occasion of Rwanda's 14th Anniversary of the 1994 Genocide, this event will aim to remember the more than million lives lost in Rwanda in 1994; to highlight the current conditions in Rwanda, and to reassert our commitment to actively remember Rwanda and the lives lost by helping survivors and fighting to prevent genocide worldwide.
