



FIELD VOLUNTEER **Arusha and Kisongo, Tanzania**

Miracle Corners of the World (MCW) is looking for 1-2 field volunteers to spend approximately 6-12 months in Tanzania beginning as soon as possible.¹ Her/his overall responsibilities will be to:

1. Continue to build a strong Leadership Team (a small team of social entrepreneurs who lead the daily operation of the multi-functional community center) and an active advisory board at the Miracle Corners Tanzania-Arusha (MCT-A) center; oversee renovations of the physical infrastructure of the MCT-A center; and
2. Lead the development of a new community center in neighboring Kisongo. This will involve building a new Leadership Team, guiding them through the creation of basic business plans for the center's activities, building an active advisory board, and providing financial oversight for the construction of a the community center.

Field volunteer(s) will report directly to the MCW Director of Community Center Programs and will work closely with the MCT Board of Trustees, MCT-A team, MCT Country Coordinator, and other stakeholders.

Candidates are organized, self-motivated, reliable, enthusiastic, confident, target-driven, able to work independently and collaboratively, able to meet strict deadlines, and comfortable handling multiple responsibilities. Candidates possess an undergraduate degree, experience working/traveling in developing countries, and excellent interpersonal, project management, and communication skills. Candidates have experience in mentoring, leadership, entrepreneurship, and social entrepreneurship. Experience with construction and financial management is preferable but not a requirement.

Preferred candidates can self-fund their volunteer experience. In select cases, MCW may be able to cover the costs of housing, security, work-related communication and local transportation, and select other work-related expenses. Field volunteer(s) are responsible for airfare, vaccinations, travel medical and emergency evacuation insurance, food, and other costs.
