SCPS BUILDS COMMUNITY IN TANZANIA

Students from the Preston Robert Tisch Center for Hospitality, Tourism, and Sports Management collected dozens of school supplies for the Idris Abdulwakil Primary School located in the Kinondoni Municipal Council, Dar Es Salaam.

The supplies were delivered to the school by alumni who visited the country to participate in the International Institute for Peace Through Tourism's second African conference.

While there, Tisch Center alumni and other conference participants visited the school. In addition to distributing the supplies they repaired two of the old classrooms which were in desperate need of restoration. Activities included: cementing the floors, patching-up and painting walls, installing windows and constructing benches and bookshelves. These efforts made a tremendous difference to the students and faculty.
